

Little's Crafts Instructions

Day 2: Gearing Up!

Supply Check

- 1 – tool belt that says, Jesus! My strong foundation!
- 1 – plastic yellow hard hat
- 3 – permanent markers
- A few foam stickers
- A few stickers
- Gear sponges (from day 1)
- Nut/bolts (from day 1)
- Paint (from day 1)
- 1 - placemat

Instructions

Tool Belt Instructions

1. Set up your workspace. Be sure to lay down the placemat first to protect your work area.
2. Lay your apron out flat, with the words face up towards the ceiling.
3. Decide how you would like to decorate your apron. You might want to use the permanent marker to draw with. You might also want to use the paint with the gear sponges and nuts and bolts. The stickers won't stick well to the apron, so we don't suggest using those now. We'll use those on our hard hat in a little bit.
4. If you're using the paint, you might want to scoop just a little paint onto a separate plate, and use the sponges or nuts and bolts as stamps again, just like yesterday,

PRO TIP: Less is best. You don't want a lot of paint on the sponge, or it will not come out clearly

5. Wait for the paint to dry completely before use. If you only used permanent marker, your tool belt is ready for use!

Hard Hat Instructions

1. Grab your hard hat.
2. Decide how you would like to decorate your hard hat. We suggest only using the permanent markers, but you may choose to use the paint as well. If you decide to use the paint, we suggest doing that as the last step. Draw and place your stickers first, then paint.
6. And again, if you're using the paint, you might want to scoop just a little paint onto a separate plate, and use the sponges or nuts and bolts as stamps again, just like yesterday,
