

PRO TIP: Less is best. You don't want a lot of paint on the sponge, or it will not come out clearly

3. Wait for the paint to dry completely before use. If you only used permanent marker, your hard hat is ready for use!

You will reuse the sponges and nuts/bolts in day 3. Please do not throw away

Little's Crafts Instructions

Day 3: Dream Car

Supply Check

- 1 wooden car
- 3 Paint cups from day 1
- 1 Paint brush
- 1 bowl
- Stickers
- Gear sponges from day 1
- Nuts and bolts from day 1
- placemat

Instructions

1. Set up your workspace. Be sure to lay down the placemat first to protect your work area.
2. Decide how you want to decorate your car. You can use supplies from around your house that were not given to you in your bag. The only things you are not allowed to use are electronic motors. If you want to try and make your car go faster, you can add anything you'd like.
3. Once you have made your plan, it's time to follow it!
4. Remember, if you are using paint, please be sure that it has time to dry completely before trying to draw or put stickers on.
5. You may also choose to use the sponges, and nuts and bolts from day 1, to decorate your car. You don't have to but they are there if you'd like!
6. Again, you might want to add other decorations that aren't included in your craft bag. If you plan on racing your car on July 17th, we simply ask that no electronic parts are added. But feel free to use anything else to improve your car.
